Takahiro Masuda, MD, PhD, is an upper gastrointestinal surgeon at the Jikei University Hospital in Tokyo Japan.

He is an expert in esophageal diseases, and his research interests include diseases of the esophagus and the foregut. He is a member of the Japan Surgical Society, the Japanese Society of Gastroenterological Surgery, the Japan Society for Endoscopic Surgery, and the Japan Esophageal Society. He was awarded Paul C. Samson Resident Prize at the Western Thoracic Surgical Association Annual Meeting in 2019, Young Investigator Award at the Japan Digestive Disease Week in 2019, and Rising Star status at the General Meeting of the Japanese Society of Gastroenterology in 2021.

Dr. Masuda graduated from the Jikei University School of Medicine in Tokyo, Japan in 2010, where he received his MD and PhD. He completed an internship and general surgery residency at the Jikei University Hospital in Tokyo.
