

Pierfrancesco Visaggi is a Gastroenterology Fellow and a PhD Candidate at the University of Pisa, Italy, where he also works as digestive endoscopist. In addition, he is a Honorary Research Fellow at Guy's and St. Thomas' Hospital in London, United Kingdom.
